

EXPEDITION PAINTBALL SCENARIO

EPS RULEBOOK

PAINTBALL RULES

1. General Rules

- By entering the playing field, every player accepts these rules.
- Instructions from game management and marshals must always be followed.
- Fairness, respect, and safety always come first.
- Alcohol or drug use on the playing field is strictly prohibited.

2. Safety Rules

- Protective masks must never be removed while on the playing field.
- Masks must fully protect the eyes, ears, and face.
- Outside the playing field, markers may only be carried with a barrel sock or barrel plug attached.
- Maximum muzzle velocity: **280 FPS**
- Every marker may be checked before the game begins.

3. Conduct on the Playing Field

- A player is considered hit once a paintball visibly breaks.
- Hits on markers or equipment also count.
- Hit players must loudly call "Hit!" and immediately leave the playing field.
- No intentional overshooting.
- No physical attacks or insults.
- Blind firing is prohibited.

4. Field Rules

- Climbing on obstacles is only allowed when explicitly permitted.
- Moving or damaging field structures is prohibited.
- Trash must be disposed of in designated bins.

5. Spectators & Safe Zone

- Spectators are not allowed to enter the playing field.
- Shooting into the opposing team's safe zone is prohibited.
- Shooting out of your own safe zone is allowed.

6. Game Management

- Issue warnings to players.

- Remove players from the game.
- Stop games for safety reasons.

7. Liability

- Participation is at your own risk.
- No liability is accepted for personal belongings.
- Every player is responsible for handling equipment responsibly.

8. Most Important Principle

Safety before fun.

Only those who play safely ensure a good experience for all participants.

CAMPING RULES

1. General Information

- By entering the campsite, every guest accepts these rules.
- Instructions from staff must always be followed.
- Respect, cleanliness, and considerate behavior are expected at all times.

2. Quiet Hours

- Night quiet hours: 10:00 PM – 7:00 AM
- Music, loud conversations, and generators are prohibited during this time.
- Vehicles may only be moved during quiet hours in exceptional cases.

3. Campsites & Camping Areas

- Camping is only permitted in assigned areas.
- Emergency routes and access roads must remain clear at all times.
- Tents, gazebos, and vehicles may only be placed within your assigned pitch.

4. Power Supply

- Electrical connections may only be used as intended.
- Unauthorized modifications to the power supply are prohibited.
- Cables must be safely positioned to avoid tripping hazards.

5. Fire & Grilling

- Open fires are only permitted in designated areas.
- Campfires must never be left unattended.

- During periods of high fire risk, fires may be prohibited.

6. Waste & Cleanliness

- Every guest is responsible for keeping their area clean.
- Waste must be separated and disposed of properly.
- Chemical toilets may only be emptied at designated stations.

7. Sanitary Facilities

- Facilities must be left clean and tidy.
- Damage or contamination must be reported immediately.

8. Vehicles

- Walking speed applies throughout the campsite.
- Vehicles may only be parked in designated areas.

9. Animals

- Pets must always be kept on a leash.
- Animal waste must be cleaned up immediately.

10. Safety

- Carrying dangerous objects or weapons is prohibited.
- Emergency exits and rescue routes must remain clear.

11. Liability

- Entering and using the campsite is at your own risk.
- Parents are responsible for their children.

12. Removal from the Campsite

- Serious rule violations may result in removal from the premises.
